10/8/11 (Sat) - FALL BIKE RIDE

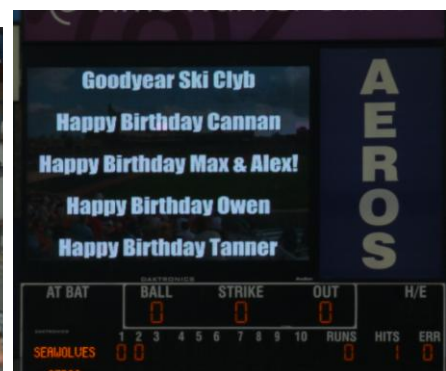

Trip Committee Report

Your trip committee continues working on trips for the 2011-2012 ski season:

January 2012 - We announced our trip to **Sun Valley, Idaho** in the June Newsletter. As of July 25th, there were 15 skiers signed up on this 28-person trip. The trip is now open to the general public. See page 3 for additional trip details.

February 2012 - I am happy to announce that the price on our ski trip to **Winter Park, Colorado has been reduced to \$939, including the first two bags.** The trip is a Thursday to Tuesday ski trip, which keeps costs down and reduces the number of work days missed. We now have 26 seats available. As of July 25th, we have two people signed up. While subject to change, currently we now have direct flights from Akron/Canton to Denver, out and back. We plan to name a trip leader in the September newsletter. Until then, I am listed on the trip ad in this newsletter on page 6.

March 2012 - We have made an arrangement with the Cleveland Metro Ski Council (CMSC) to "adopt" their March trip to **Big Sky, Montana, March 17-24.** We would have 28 spots. The cost is estimated to be \$1350-\$1400. The trip will include airfare from Akron/Canton (or Cleveland), and lodging at the Huntley Hotel with ski-in/ski-out access. CMSC is close to working out the final trip details. Look for a full announcement in the September newsletter.

The financial audit, as required by the Club's constitution, was completed on July 14, 2011. Audit was performed by **Jerry Solnick, Chris Kraszewski, and Randy Grether**. Also in attendance were **Bill Nappi**, Treasurer, and **Warren Ripple**, Trip Chair.

KEY FINDINGS

*** The audit group found no evidence of fraud.

*** The event folders showed significant improvement.

*** Participant refunds are reported as adjustments to income, while vendor/agent refunds are reported as adjustments to expense, both in compliance with audit recommendations.

During the audit, several areas of concern were discussed. They are as follows:

- A) All trip folders were audited. The trip folders continue to show year over year improvement in the quality of the record keeping that is being documented. Almost all folders were completed within Club guidelines. The accounting for cash has improved. Cash received and cash spent are now recorded as separate line items. There were some minor omissions of receipts. Receipts for expenditures, as much as practical, should continue to be a point of emphasis.
- B) All social event folders were also audited. The major concern with the social event folders revolve around complete and accurate accounting of income and expenses, and preparation of the event Balance Sheet. When using cash receipts to pay expenses, DO NOT NET the income and expenses on reports. All cash received and all cash spent need to be recorded as separate line items! Income is normally in the form of event fees collected from Club members and guests. Expenses are normally for food, beverage, prizes, rental fees, or other items. Obtaining receipts for expenditures, as much as practical, should continue to be a point of emphasis. Please identify these expenditures as cash items.
- C) For all Club events that require a fee to attend, the event leader must complete a list of all event participants, the amount of money collected from each, and the check number or specify cash. The Club's deposit form should be utilized for this accounting. Most events met this requirement.
- D) The Goodyear Ski Club uses the 'Voucher System (dual signature)' for check disbursements. Event folders should contain all vouchers used to pay event expenses. Most events met this requirement.

The Audit Committee suggests:

- 1) To provide the Audit Committee with the Treasurer's Annual Report and Receipts/Disbursements Reports for the year being audited.
- 2) It is recommended that folders be created and maintained for Local Ski Night, business meetings, Trip Committee meetings, and Officer reimbursements.
- 3) The Treasurer meet with new Officers having responsibility to monitor trip/event financial reports.
- 4) That the responsible Officer provide sample event folders to each social event and trip leader. The sample event folder should contain samples of the various accounting forms that have been established by the Club to record income, expenses, event attendees, and any other areas of accountability for the event.
- 5) The Vice President, who acts as the point of contact for all social events, should ensure that each social event leader is furnished this sample event folder, and made aware of the Club's requirements for accountability of money collected and spent on behalf of the Club.
- 6) The Trip Chair, being the point of contact for all Trip Coordinators, should ensure that all reporting requirements are followed.
- 7) In the event of Financial Report questions or concerns, the Trip Chair or Vice President should contact the Treasurer to ensure reporting consistency.

Goodyear Ski Club, Inc (GSC) Trip Agreement / Release and Trip Application Form

Unless otherwise noted, all prices are "per person". All trip reservations require a signed application with payment. Make all checks payable to the Goodyear Ski Club, Inc.

CANCELLATION AND/OR CHANGES: GSC reserves the right to: (1) withdraw the trip; (2) refuse, at any time, to accept or retain any person as a trip participant; and/or (3) prior to departure, make changes in published itinerary, whenever, in its sole judgment, conditions warrant. **Unforeseen costs from changes to air travel, ground travel, lift tickets or rooming will be passed onto the trip participants.**

ROOMING PREFERENCES: Due to the nature of our trips, the number of participants, the bedding configuration, and the accommodations secured for the trip participants, the GSC can not guarantee that the requested rooming preference will be provided.

SINGLE SUPPLEMENT CHARGES: Room rates are based upon double occupancy. If you are a single participant, without a roommate preference, every effort will be made to find you a roommate. If that is not possible, you will be required to pay any single supplement charges that may be imposed.

RESPONSIBILITY: GSC is acting as the applicant's agent and will not be liable for any loss or damage to baggage or property, or any personal injury, or any other loss occurring or occasioned by applicant's participation or lack of participation in a trip. GSC will not be responsible for any cost increase(s) due to increases in local, state, or Federal taxes, fuel surcharges, baggage fees, etc. Any participant under 18 years of age must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.

REFUNDS: Applicant will receive a full refund if the GSC cancels a trip, except and unless such cancellation is necessitated or caused, either wholly or in part, by applicant's cancellation or failure to make timely payment. 1) Where applicant cancels at any time and trip departs 100% filled, the applicant may be entitled to a refund, less a \$5 service charge on any one day trip; a \$15 service charge on any weekend trip; or a \$25 service charge on any trip over three days. 2) Where applicant cancels and a trip departs less than 100% filled, the applicant may be liable for the entire cost of the applicant's trip, including deposit, final payment and/or balance due. 3) Applicant shall be liable to the GSC for any monies expended or paid by GSC over and above payments made by the applicant to the GSC.

RELEASE: In consideration of being permitted to participate in trip activities, by signing the application, I, as an individual hereby release the GSC, its officers and agents, from all liability for injury, death, damage or loss resulting from such participation. I understand the dangers inherent in trip activities and acknowledge that I have had an opportunity to make all necessary inquiries regarding the transportation and facilities involved. I release the GSC to use my likeness which may appear on their website to publicize their ski trips, which may appear in their photo albums or which may appear in other media used to publicize the GSC and its activities. I intend this release to be binding on my heirs and personal representatives. If I am the parent or legal guardian of a trip participant, I intend the above release to be applicable to the participant as well as to me.

FUEL SURCHARGES: The GSC may incur additional fuel surcharges to the contracted transportation at any time before trip departure. It is the responsibility of the participant to pay any such increases. Participants having any questions regarding this policy should contact their trip leader.

NSF CHECK: For any check returned for insufficient funds, the participant will be assessed a \$25 minimum return check fee, plus any daily penalties incurred by the GSC. The return of any check will be cause for cash payments to be made to the GSC Treasurer. If checks are returned for insufficient funds, the Treasurer shall notify the participant and allow him/her fourteen (14) days to cover the check. If funds have not been paid within the fourteen day period, the member may lose his/her position on any GSC trip or activity.

POST-DATED CHECK: No post-dated check(s) will be accepted for any GSC trip.

TRIPS OUT OF THE COUNTRY: You must have a current passport, which does not expire until 6 months after your return. If you have been convicted of a crime, including D.U.I., you may be refused entry into the subject country and should contact the country's embassy or Consular General for the proper procedure or clearance. The GSC is not responsible for the denied entry.

ASSOCIATE MEMBER: To protect the GSC's non-profit status, each non-member is charged an Associate Membership fee based upon a non-refundable fee structure of: \$5 for each one day trip; \$10 for each weekend trip; and \$25 for any trip longer than three days. This fee allows an individual to participate on a current season ski trip. Within one month from the ending date of the respective trip, the Associate Membership fee may be applied toward a full membership. The fee does not entitle the Associate Member to receive the monthly newsletter or any other GSC benefits. The Associate Membership fee will be in effect only after a trip is opened to non-members.

NOTE: NOT INCLUDED – Any items not specifically mentioned as part of the trip, such as: meals, phone calls, transportation to the point of trip departure, items of a personal nature, fees charged for airlines for checked baggage, etc. are the sole responsibility of the trip participant.
